

#### HMS AMBUSCADE



The present HMS AMBUSCADE is the seventh ship in the Royal navy to hold the name. She was the first Amazon Class Type 21 frigate to be built by Yarrows Ltd of Glasgow and was launched by lady Griffin, wife of the Controller of the Navy, on 17 January 1973. HMS AMBUSCADE commissioned into the Royal Navy on 5 September 1975. The ship's busy and varied career has taken from Europe east through the Mediterranean to Singapore and Malaysia, south to the Falklands and west to the United States and South America. Her career has encompassed all aspects of a warship's life from exercise to guardship duties and from peacetime visits to the full heat of the war in the Falklands Islands.



#### PNS TARIQ



Pakistan inherited a very small number of ships from the Royal India Navy soon after its independence in 1947. One of these ships was HM TARIQ, which was named after a gallant Muslim conqueror TARIQ BIN ZIYAD. His conquest of Gibraltar led to the extension of the Muslim rule of Europe. The life of TARIQ BIN ZIYAD is full of achievements which are a source of great inspiration to Muslims all over the world; sailors of the Pakistan Navy are no exception. They take great pride in serving onboard any ship that has been named after one of the greatest personalities in Islamic history.

The second ship to be named after TARIQ BIN ZIYAD was one of the first two Gearing Class ships to join the Pakistan Navy in 1979. After rendering nine years of glorious service, the ship was decommissioned and handed over to the Maritime Security Agency in 1988, and subsequently renamed MSS NAZIM. The association of the Pakistan Navy to this name has led to the naming of the first Type 21 frigate into the Pakistan Navy as PNS TARIQ.
